**Caddie Policy:** Caddies are allowed at all MGJGT events. Each player shall designate their caddy before starting the first round. Caddies may be replaced by the player at anytime but may only have one caddie at a time. Each player must walk and carry their clubs or use a caddie. Players may use pull carts if desired. A player with a physical disability may be exempt from this policy. Contact the MGJGT Tour Director with any questions.

**Carts/Spectator Policy:**

Parents and spectators are welcome to attend all tournaments. The rules for parents, spectators and carts are as follows:

- Spectators, parents and spectator carts must stay on cart paths at all times.
- Cell phones and beepers must be kept in silent mode or turned off at all times. Repeat phone violators will be asked to return to the club house if devices are used.
- Spectators are allowed to carry water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for the players.
- Spectators are not allowed to give advice to players.

**PLAYERS MAY BE PENALIZED FOR Rule 8-1 in the USGA Rules of Golf.**

“Advice is any counsel or suggestion, which could influence a player in determining his play, the choice of a club or the method of making a stroke. Information on the Rules or public information, such as course yardage, course hazards or pin locations, is not advice.”

- Spectators are allowed to assist and search for lost golf balls.
- Spectators must stay away from the players when turning in scorecards in the scoring tent.

**Pace of Play Policy:**

The MGJGT shall enforce the USGA Rules of Golf, Rule 6-7. “The player must play without undue delay. The penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes in stroke play, or loss of hole in match play. The penalty for multiple offenses is disqualification. The MGJGT will educate golfers and enforce policy to maintain the integrity of the game.
